






## ANTI-SEIZE LUBRICANT MUST BE USED ON ALL STAINLESS STEEL FASTENERS TO PREVENT THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING.

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
- 2. If equipped, remove the factory tow hooks.
- 3. Remove plastic splash guards from beneath vehicle.
- 4. Use the template provided with this kit to make a center mark (Item 25). Use a 2" hole saw to cut a hole at the center mark (Figure 1). Remove the exposed M10 bolt from on each side of the bumper.





- 5. Trim tow access cover. (Figure 2).
- 6. Slip the supplied winch tray mounting brackets (2 & 3) into the frame rails (Figure 2) and loosely secure them with the supplied M12 hardware (Figure 3).
- 7. Loosely install the Winch Tray to the mounting brackets using the supplied M10 and M12 hardware (Figure 3).
- 8. Tighten and torque M10 hardware to 30-35 ft-lbs, M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs. (Skip this step if installing a grill guard).
- 9. Install the winch per the winch manufacturer's instructions. Note: Many winches cannot be installed once the grille guard has been bolted in place.





- 10. Loosely install the upper mount brackets through the holes previously made (Items 16 & 17 shown) using the M10 socked head bolts and cupped washers (Figure 4).
- 11. With the help of an assistant, install the grill guard using the button head bolts (Items 21 & 22) as shown in (Figure 4).
- 12. Align and adjust as needed.
- 13. Tighten and torque all remaining hardware; M10 to 30-35 ft-lbs., M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.





## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
