
PROCEDURE

1

Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Beginning on the passenger side of the vehicle near the back of the sliding door, remove the black rubber plug in the location shown in **Figure 1**.
- 3. Insert a Short M8 Bolt Plate (item 3) into the rear passenger side mounting hole and use a M8 plastic retainer (item 11) to keep it in place.
- 4. Loosely install the Passenger Side Bracket "B" (item 2) using the supplied M8 hardware (items 4-6) and adjust it to the desired location.
- 5. Mark the two bottom hole locations and drill two 5/16" holes. See **Figure 2**.
- 6. Loosely install the M6 hardware (items 7-10) using the holes drilled in the previous step. See Figure 2.
- 7. Repeat **steps 2-6** for the Passenger Side Bracket "A" (**item 1**). *Note:* The mounting location for Passenger Side Bracket "A" is 39.4 inches from the mounting location for Passenger Side Bracket "B" towards the front of the vehicle.
- 8. Refer to the installation sheet included with the Grate Steps Running Boards for running board installation instructions.
- 9. Align and adjust the brackets and running board as needed.
- 10. Tighten and torque all hardware installed to the provided torque specs: M6 hardware to 7 ft-lbs, M8 hardware to 18 ft-lbs.






CARE INSTRUCTIONS
