
# PROCEDURE

 Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

- 2. Open the hood and remove the bolts attaching the top of the grille to the truck. See Figure 1.
- 3. On each side, remove the panel shown in Figure 2 and remove the hardware underneath. See Figure 2.
- 4. Remove the (4) bolts attaching the bottom of the grille to the truck.




- 5. Remove the grille from the truck, disconnect any cables or tubes connected to the grille.
- 6. Remove the plastic panels circled in Figure 3.









- 7. On each side, remove (2) bolts attaching the bumper to the body mount. See Figure 4.
- 8. Disconnect all cables from the front bumper.
- 9. On each side, remove the (4) bolts shown in **Figure 5**.
- 10. Remove the front bumper.







- 11. Remove the factory tow hooks. *Note:* Factory tow hooks will not be re-used. See Figure 6.
- 12. Loosely install the driver winch tray mount bracket "A" (item 2) where the tow hook was removed using M12 hardware (items 6-9). The (4) M12 bolts are installed where the (4) factory bolts were removed in the previous step. See Figure 7.








- 13. Loosely install the driver winch tray mount bracket "B" (item 4) onto the driver winch tray mount bracket "A" using the M10 hardware (items 10-12). See Figure 8.
- 14. Repeat Steps 12 and 13 on the passenger side of the truck.
- 15. Reinstall the bumper. Attach the bumper to the winch tray mount brackets using the factory bolts and M12 hardware (items 7-9).





- 16. Trim the bumper panels. See Figure 9.
- 17. Reinstall the trimmed bumper panels.
- 18. Reinstall the grille.





- 19. Install the winch tray (item 1) onto the winch tray brackets using the M12 hardware (items 13-16). See Figure 10.
- 20. Aadjust the brackets and grille guard as needed. Tighten hardware to the following specifications: M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs, M10 to 30-35 ft-lbs.
- 21. Install the winch in the winch tray.







# PROCEDURE

- Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

- 2. Open the hood and remove the bolts attaching the top of the grille to the truck. See Figure 1.
- 3. On each side, remove the panel shown in Figure 2 and remove the hardware underneath. See Figure 2.
- 4. Remove the (4) bolts attaching the bottom of the grille to the truck.







- 5. Remove the grille from the truck, disconnect any cables or tubes connected to the grille.
- 6. Remove the plastic panels circled in **Figure 3**.










- 7. On each side, remove (2) bolts attaching the bumper to the body mount. See Figure 4.
- 8. Disconnect all cables from the front bumper.
- 9. On each side, remove the (4) bolts shown in **Figure 5**.
- 10. Remove the front bumper.







- 11. Remove the factory tow hooks. *Note:* Factory tow hooks will not be re-used. See Figure 6.
- 12. Loosely install the driver winch tray mount bracket "A" (item 2) where the tow hook was removed using M12 hardware (items 6-9). The (4) M12 bolts are installed where the (4) factory bolts were removed in the previous step. See Figure 7.










- 13. Loosely install the driver winch tray mount bracket "B" (item 4) onto the driver winch tray mount bracket "A" using the M10 hardware (items 10-12). See Figure 8.
- 14. Repeat Steps 12 and 13 on the passenger side of the truck.
- 15. Reinstall the bumper. Attach the bumper to the winch tray mount brackets using the factory bolts and M12 hardware (items 7-9).



- 16. On each side of the truck, remove the factory bracket and hardware shown in Figure 9.
- 17. One each side of the truck, loosely install (1) lower support bracket (item 18) on the outside of the frame where the factory hardware was removed in the previous step. See Figure 10. Trim the bumper valence as needed to install the lower support bracket.








- 18. Trim the bumper panels. See Figure 11.
- 19. Reinstall the trimmed bumper panels.
- 20. Reinstall the grille.




21. Install the winch tray (item 1) onto the winch tray brackets using the M12 hardware (items 13-16). See Figure 12. 22. Install the winch in the winch tray.









- 23. Remove the (2) center parking sensors from the front bumper.
- 24. Remove the cover panels and rubber hole plugs from the grille guard lower tube. See Figure 13.
- 25. Insert (1) sensor harness extender (item 21) into the lower grille guard tube. Place one end of the harness extender in the space behind the cover panel. See Figure 13.
- 26. Place (1) piece of double sided tape (item 36) on the back of each parking sensor.
- 27. Install the parking sensors using the M6 hardware (items 29-31) and the sensor L-brackets (items 22-23). See Figure 14.





- Loosely install the grille guard assembly (item 17) onto the winch tray and brackets using the black M12 hardware (items 32-34). See Figure 15.
- 29. Adjust the brackets and grille guard as needed. Tighten hardware to the following specifications: M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs, M10 to 30-35 ft-lbs, M6 to 5-7 ft-lbs.
- 30. Connect the sensor harness extenders to the parking sensors and bumper sensor harness.
- 31. Reinstall the cover panels.
- 32. Place the rubber hole plugs into the empty sensor holes in the bumper.
- 33. Use the zip ties (item 35) to hold the sensor harness extenders in place.
