




PROCEDURE

Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.


- 2. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See **Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the four bolts holding the grille in place. See **Figure 2**.
- 4. Remove 2 bolts attaching wheel well cover to filler panel. See Figure 3.










- 5. Pry off fenders to access the filler panel clips. See Figure 4.
- 6. Pry filler panel off removing any necessary bolts. See Figure 5.
- 7. Disconnect any electrical plugs and any bolts still attaching the grill to the vehicle. See **Figure 6.**
- 8. Pry remaining clips attaching the grill to the vehicle to remove the grille.












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
- 9. Remove 4 upper bumper bolts attaching the bumper to the frame and remove 2 bottom bolts attaching bumper arm to the frame. See **Figure 7 & 8.**
- 10. Remove Bumper.





- 11. Locate the lower driver mounting brackets for the MAX winch tray. Using the supplied M12 hardware, loosely install the mounting brackets on to the frame. Slide the mounting bracket (3) in between the frame. The support bracket (5) goes under the frame. See Figure 9 & 10.
- 12. Repeat on the passenger side.






13. Locate the upper support straps (7 and 8) for the grille guard. Loosely re-install the front bumper with the upper support straps. *Note: Trimming of tow pocket is required.* Trim out the tow hook pockets as necessary for the bracket clearance. The winch mount brackets will slide right through the previously trimmed tow hook pockets when reinstalling the bumper. Reconnect all electrical connections. The upper factory bumper bolts will be used for the upper support straps. Measure the distance between the mounting surfaces of the upper straps and ensure it is about 42.25". Torque to 50-55 ft-lbs.







2024+ Upper Strap "B"

- 14. Remove the plastic trim shown in **Figure 16**.
- 15. Locate the upper support straps "B" (items 36 and 37). Loosely re-install the front bumper with the upper support straps "B". Reconnect all electrical connections. The upper factory bumper bolts will be used for the upper support straps.
- 16. Cut the plastic trim removed in Step 15 so that the bolt can be accessed. The results should look like **Figure 16**.
- 17. Reinstall the plastic cover. See Figure 16.
- 18. Measure the distance between the mounting surfaces of the upper straps "B" and ensure it is about 42.25". Torque to 50-55 ft-lbs.







19. Re-install the front bumper and reconnect all electrical connections. *Note: Trimming of tow pocket is required.* Trim out the tow hook pockets as necessary for the bracket clearance. **See Figure 18.**




- 20. Locate the Winch Tray (2) and using the supplied flanged M12 Hardware, loosely assemble the Winch Tray to the mounting brackets. See **Figure 19**
- 21. If you are installing a winch, do so at this time. Adjust as needed and torque all hardware as specified: M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs.





22. **If installing the HDX grille guard: Install winch first!** Locate the spacer blocks (9) and using supplied M12 hardware, mount the spacer blocks to the winch tray. **See Figure 20**





- 23. Reinstall the filler panel and grille.
- 24. With help, install the Grille Guard over the spacer blocks and previously installed upper support brackets. Using the supplied M12 hardware. See **Figures 21 & 22.**
- 25. Align as necessary and torque all hardware as specified: M12 to 50-55 ft-lbs., M10 to 30-35 ft-lbs.




