

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PROCEDURE


1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation. Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




- 2. Open the hood of the vehicle and remove the plastic cover at the front using a pry tool. See Figure 1 for reference.
- 3. Remove the four bolts holding the grille in place. See Figure 2 for reference.
- 4. Remove 2 bolts attaching wheel well cover to filler panel. See Figure 3 for reference.




- 5. Pry off fenders to access the filler panel clips. See Figure 4 for reference.
- 6. Pry filler panel off removing any necessary bolts. See Figure 5 for reference.
- 7. Disconnect any electrical plugs and any bolts still attaching the grill to the vehicle. See Figure 6 for reference.
- 8. Pry remaining clips attaching the grill to the vehicle to remove the grille.






- 9. Remove 4 upper bumper bolts attaching the bumper to the frame and remove 2 bottom bolts attaching bumper arm to the frame. See Figure 7 & 8 for reference.
- 10. Remove Bumper.





11. Locate the lower driver mounting and support brackets for the Grille Guard. Using the supplied M12 hardware, loosely install the mounting brackets on to the frame. The mounting bracket and support bracket (4-7) sandwich the frame. See Figure 9 & 10.

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12. Repeat on the passenger side.









Bumper Valence Cutting Instructions 2020-2023


- 13. Locate the driver and passenger cutting templates (22-23). Starting on either side, along the template to the top corner of the valence. See Figure 11. Tape the template to the valence.
- 14. Using Figures 11 & 12, ensure that the measurements match your template. Follow the template instructions and cut accordingly. Note: *After cutting, you will still need to adjust your brackets and more cutting may be required!*






Bumper Valence Cutting Instructions 2024+


- 15. Locate the driver and passenger cutting templates "B" (19 & 20). Tape the driver side cutting template to the lower valence so that that the corner lines up with the edges shown below in **Figure 13**.
- 16. Repeat step 15 on the passenger side using the passenger cutting template "B".
- 17. Using Figure 13, ensure that the measurements match your template. Follow the template instructions and cut accordingly. Note: *After cutting, you will still need to adjust your brackets and more cutting may be required!*






2020-2023 Upper Strap "A"

Locate the upper support straps "A" (6-7) for the grille guard. Loosely re-install the front bumper with the upper support straps. Reconnect all electrical connections. The upper factory bumper bolts will be used for the upper support straps. Measure the distance between the mounting surfaces of the upper straps and ensure it is about 42.25". Torque to 50-55 ft-lbs. See Figure 14 & 15.









2024+ Upper Strap "B"

- 19. Remove the plastic trim shown in **Figure 16**.
- 20. Locate the upper support straps "B" (**items 36 and 37**). Loosely re-install the front bumper with the upper support straps "B". Reconnect all electrical connections. The upper factory bumper bolts will be used for the upper support straps.
- 21. Cut the plastic trim removed in Step 15 so that the bolt can be accessed. The results should look like Figure 16.
- 22. Reinstall the plastic cover. See Figure 16.
- 23. Measure the distance between the mounting surfaces of the upper straps "B" and ensure it is about 42.25". Torque to 50-55 ft-lbs.







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



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
- 24. Reinstall the filler panel and the grille in the reverse order as instructed previously.
- 25. With assistance, install the HDX Grille Guard Base onto the Lower Mounting Brackets and previously installed Upper Support Straps using the supplied M10 and M12 hardware. See Figures 18 & 19 for reference. <u>Note:</u> The Upper Support Strap mounting location will be shared with the HDX Driver and Passenger Wings installed in Step 19.
- Locate and install the HDX Driver and Passenger Wings (Items 2 & 3) using the supplied M8 hardware (Items 20-22). See Figure 20 & 21 for reference. *Note: The shared Upper Support Strap mounting location will use the M10 Hardware as mentioned before.*
- 27. Align and adjust the Modular Grille Guard assembly as necessary and torque all hardware as specified: M8 to 15-18 ft-lbs., M10 to 25-30 ft-lbs., M12 to 45-50 ft-lbs.














CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.

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GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.

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FASTENERS:

All Westin supplied fasteners must be utilized and installed in accordance with the installation instructions and apply torque to the specifications as defined. DOUBLE CHECK ALL FASTENERS BEFORE INITIAL USE, AND PERIODICALLY IN THE FUTURE TO ENSURE PROPER FUNCTION AND SAFETY.

DRILLING:

Most Westin products do not require drilling for installation. If drilling is defined as required, use caution when drilling a vehicle. FAILURE TO REVIEW AN AREA TO BE DRILLED MAY RESULT IN PERSONAL INJURY AND/OR INJURY TO OTHERS AS WELL AS VEHICLE DAMAGE.

EYE PROTECTION:

ALWAYS WEAR SAFETY GLASSES OR GOGGLES DURING THE INSTALLATION PROCESS TO AVOID PERSONAL INJURY.
