

# **PROCEDURE**


Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.


Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.




**Body Style "A" Upper Strap Bracket** 

- 2. Begin by removing the plastic clips holding the air intake splash shield in place, and remove the splash shield.
- 3. Remove the fasteners holding the grille in place. Also, dethatch the clips from the wings on the grille. See **Figures 1 & 2** for reference.
- 4. Remove the grille by pulling firmly and carefully at the bottom of the grille.






- 5. Use the OEM hardware to secure the Upper Strap Bracket (Items 4-5) to the bumper. <u>Note</u>: Bumper shown off of the vehicle for viewing purposes. See **Figure 3** for reference.
- 6. Reinstall the grille and the air intake splash shield.





# **Body Style "B" Upper Support Bracket**

- 7. Remove the three fasteners retaining the panel above the bumper from the inside of the wheel wells. See **Figure 4** for reference.
- 8. Remove the trim panel from the clips near the headlights. Use a pry tool if necessary. See **Figure 5**.






- 9. On both sides of the vehicle, use a pry tool to remove the fascia panel from the clips shown. See **Figures 6** for reference.
- 10. Remove the fascia panel above the bumper. <u>Note:</u> The fascia panel contains plastic clips retaining it to the rest of the vehicle. Pull firmly and carefully on the fascia to remove it.



- 11. Remove the plastic clips holding the air intake splash shield in place, and remove the splash shield.
- 12. Remove the fasteners retaining the grille. There are 4 fasteners along the top and three along the bottom. See **Figures 7 &** 8 for reference.
- 13. Remove the grille from the clips above the headlights. See **Figure 8** for reference.
- 14. Remove the grille by firmly and carefully pulling it away from the vehicle.
- 15. Trim and apply foam tape to the Upper Support Straps (Items 18-19). See Figure 9 for reference.
- 16. Use the OEM hardware to install the Upper Support Straps to the bumper. See Figures 9 & 10 for reference.
- 17. Adjust the support straps and torque the OEM hardware to 32 ft-lbs.












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
- 11. Remove the 4 bolts behind the plastic cover securing the bumper to the vehicle. See **Figure 11** for reference.
- 12. Remove the bolts on the bottom of the frame securing the bumper supports to the rest of the vehicle. See **Figure 12** for reference.






- 13. Once the bumper is removed from the vehicle, remove the bolts holding the plastic supports to the bumper in order to access the sensors and sensor wiring harness. Remove the sensors carefully and make sure to pay attention to the sensor orientation since they must be reinstalled in that orientation. See **Figures 13 & 14** for reference.
- 14. After you remove the sensors and harness, reinstall the plastic supports that were previously removed.







- 15. Use the OEM hardware to secure the Upper Strap Bracket (Items 4-5) to the bumper. See Figure 15 for reference.
- 16. Reinstall the OEM bumper, route the wiring harness, and then reinstall the grille **before proceeding** with the installation. See Figure 16. (NOTE- Carefully route the original harness in between the grille and the OEM bumper to be able to connect the sensor harness extensions to the OEM harness. Use the provided Zip Ties (26) to secure the harness in place. See Figure 15 for reference.)





17. Carefully trim the factory tow hook pocket area to fit the Lower Mounting Brackets (Items 2-3). See Figure 17 & 18 for reference.







# **Body Style "B" Trimming Instructions**


18. Carefully trim the factory tow hook pocket <u>and</u> lower valence area to fit the Lower Mounting Bracket (Items 2-3). See **Figures 19 through 21** for reference.

### Notes:

- Make sure you remove the rubber tow hook covers prior to trimming.
- Some vehicle trims do not have the chrome lower valence, but trimming of the plastic valence is still required.
- It is recommended to use blue masking tape to protect the area around the tow hook pocket from scratches or damage.
- It is recommended to incrementally trim, and test fit the brackets as you trim, to avoid over trimming the tow hook pocket and lower valence area.











# Body Style "A" & "B" Instructions


- 19. Unbolt the pre-installed tube covers from the grille guard by unscrewing M6 button head bolts. . See Figure 22-23
- 20. Mount the sensors onto the Grille Guard (1) in the same orientation that they were on the OEM bumper using the Sensor Tabs (11-12) and the provided M6 hardware.. See **Figure 24.** *Note:* The double sided tape (27) may be used to secure the Sensor Tabs to the Sensor.















21. Locate the Harness Extensions (9) and route the extension wire using the supplied Fish Wire (28) through the grille guard tube covers before installing the sensors. **See Figures 25-28.** 












22. Reinstall the sensor covers using the same hardware you removed. See Figure 29.





23. Install the Lower Mounting Bracket (2-3) and Lower Support Strap (6) to the frame using the supplied M12 Hardware. See **Figures 30 & 31** 






24. Use the supplied M10 and M12 Hardware (12-17) to secure the Grille Guard to the Mounting Brackets/Straps. See **Figures** 32 & 33










#### CARE INSTRUCTIONS
