





PROCEDURE


- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Disconnect all electrical connections to the rear bumper.
- 3. Remove the OEM rear bumper.


If rear parking sensors are equipped, follow Steps 4-7. If rear parking sensors are not equipped, skip to Step 8 and insert the plugs into the sensor holes.


- 4. Remove the parking sensors and wiring harness from the OEM rear bumper.
- 5. Install parking sensors by inserting them into the holes on bumper and securing them with sensor L-tabs (**item 8**). Fasten L-tabs with the supplied M6 hardware (**items 14, 16, 17, and 18**). See **Figure 1**. Place supplied double sided tape between the sensors and L-Tabs. *Note*: Be sure to maintain the orientation of the sensor so that it remains consistent with its original orientation.
- 6. Use zip ties to secure sensor in place.
- 7. Tighten M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs.




- 8. Loosely install the support brackets (item 4) using OEM double bolt plates and hex nuts removed in step 3. See Figure 2.
- 9. Loosely install the mount brackets (items 2 and 3) using the M12 hardware (items 9-12). See Figures 2 and 3.
- 10. Insert the M12 double bolt plates (item 20) into the rear bandit bumper (item 1). See Figure 4.
- 11. Loosely install the rear bandit bumper onto the mount brackets using the M12 hardware (items 9, 11, and 12). See Figure 5.









WARNING:


After you have mounted the bumper on the mount brackets, CAREFULLY open the tailgate. While the tailgate is open, adjust the height of the bumper so that there is sufficient clearance between the bumper and the tailgate.

12. Adjust the brackets and bumper. Tighten the M12 hardware to 50-55 ft-lbs.

LIGHT INSTALLATION


- 1. Disconnect the battery from your vehicle.
- 2. Locate the license plate lights (pre-installed) in the bumper. Pop out the lights by squeezing the clips in on the backside. See **Figure 6**.
- 3. Locate the factory wiring for the license plate lights. Strip back the wiring on the factory harness and supplied light. Using connectors, crimp the red wire on the positive factory wire and the black wire to the factory ground wire. **See Figure 7**.









4. Push the light back in until it clips into place. Repeat on the opposite side. See Figure 8.



- 5. Remove the light from the rubber grommet. Install the rubber grommet into the back up light location on the bumper. Then, reinstall the light into the rubber grommet. See **Figure 9-10**.
- 6. Looking at the backside of the lower reverse lights, there are three wires: a ground wire, optional (off road only) tail light wire, and a reverse light (bright) wire. Using the figure below, connect the reverse light wire to the factory reverse light harness, and ground wire to a factory ground wire. If using the optional tail light wire, connect the Tail light wire to a switch. See **Figure 10**.
- 7. Reconnect your battery.








