

PROCEDURE

 Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.

OE Bumper Removal

- 2. Remove the bolts that are located on the top of the grille, attached to the radiator support. See Figure 1 for reference.
- 3. Remove the plastic clips and the electrical connectors that are located on the driver and passenger side of the front bumper. See **figure 2 & 3** for reference.
- 4. Remove the bolts and plastic clips that are located by the fenders and on the bottom of the front bumper
- 5. Remove the fender flares and using a flat head screwdriver pop out the side of the front bumper. Repeat on the driver side. See Figure 4 & 5 for reference.
- 6. Continue by pulling the front bumper assembly off the truck. Some force will be needed






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OE Bumper Disassembly and Trimming


- 6. Cautiously disconnect all four front parking sensors attached on the front bumper. See Figure 6, 7, & 8 for reference. <u>NOTE:</u> Make sure to cautiously disconnect the sensor and remember the location and orientation to prevent any malfunctions.
- To begin to disassemble the front bumper, start by removing the left and the right side of the bumper which is held on by 6 screws. See Figure 6 & 7 for reference. <u>NOTE:</u> The wire harness will be removed as the front bumper is disassembled along the way.
- 8. Remove the bolts and wire connector on the top right that hold the active shutters. See Figure 8 for reference.





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- 9. Proceed by removing the screws located all around the border of the front bumper. See Figure 9, 10, & 11 for reference.
- 10. Begin removing the plastic clips all along the edge of the front bumper. This will remove the top trim piece of the assembly. See Figure 9, 10, & 11 for reference.
- 11. To remove the front gloss piece of the grille, remove the plastic clips. See Figure 9, 10, & 11 for reference.
- 12. Begin removing the plastic clips that holds the wire harness to disassemble the front bumper assembly












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
- 13. Carefully disconnect and remove the bolts that hold the cruise control sensor. See **Figure 12** for reference. <u>NOTE:</u> When handling the sensor make sure to place the sensor in a safe space to prevent any malfunction.
- 14. Disconnect the two wires that are connected to the fog lights. Continue to take out any clips that are holding the wire harness together. See **Figure 13** for reference.
- 15. Continue to remove the last two pieces of the assembly by removing the plastic clips. See Figure 13 for reference.








- 16. Prep the location that is located on both the left and right side of the assembly piece. See Figure 14 & 15 for reference.
- 17. Trim the center of the assembly piece. See Figure 16, 17, & 18 for Reference.
- 18. Once finished reassemble the front bumper. *NOTE: Cautiously install the front parking sensors as they were at the beginning of the disassembly. Cautiously install the cruise control to prevent any accidents.*






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





Pro-Series Install


<u>NOTE</u>: Figure 19 is shown to demonstrate where to apply the Edge Trim (Item 10) if the Pro-Series Bumper does not have it already pre-installed.

19. Remove the aluminum crash bar from the frame of the vehicle and the factory skid plate (14m 11) through the frame. See Figure 20 & 21 for reference











- 21. Locate the Driver Bracket (Item 3) and using the M12 hardware (Items 19, 20, & 22) provided loosely attach it to the frame of the vehicle. See Figure 22 for reference.
- 22. Locate the Support Driver Bracket (Item 7) and using the M12 hardware (Item 19, 20, & 22) provided loosely attach it to the frame of the vehicle and to the Driver Bracket (Item 3). See Figure 23 for reference.
- 23. Locate the Frame Support Driver Bracket (Item 5) and using the M12 hardware (Item 18-22) provided loosely attach it to the frame of the vehicle and to the Driver Bracket (Item 3). Line up the Frame Support Driver Bracket with the hole and the M12 Bolt Plate (Item 11) that was placed previously. See Figure 24 & 25 for reference.
- 24. Repeat Step 22-24 on the passenger side of the vehicle.










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
25. Insert the Pro-Series Front Bumper (Item 1) and using the M12 hardware (Items 19, 20, & 22) provided loosely attach it to the Driver Bracket (Item 3) and Passenger Bracket (Item 4). See Figure 25 & 26 for reference.




26. Locate the Skid Plate Bracket (Item 9) and using the M12 hardware begin to loosely attach it to the Pro-Series Front Bumper (Item 1). See Figure 27 & 28 for reference.



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- 27. Use the provided M8 hardware (Item 15-17) and M12 hardware (Item 19-22) loosely attach the Skid Plate (Item 2) to the vehicle and to he Pro-Series Front Bumper (Item 1). See Figure 29 for reference.
- 28. Align and adjust the Pro-Series Front Bumper and Mounting Brackets as necessary. Fully tighten and torque all hardware as specified: M6 hardware to 5-7 ft-lbs., M8 hardware to 15-18 ft-lbs., and M12 hardware to 55-60 ft-lbs.
- 29. Reinstall the front bumper of the vehicle. <u>NOTE:</u> Make sure to add all plastic clips and connect any wires to be able to prevent any errors from happening.
