





#### **PROCEDURE**

Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage.
 Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.

Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.


- 2. Begin the installation by removing the bumper.
- 3. Start by detaching the main wiring harness located on the driver side. See Figure 1
- 4. Disconnect the trailer plug. Figure 2
- 5. Start by removing bumper bolts located at the side of the frame see Figure 3.








6. Remove the (4) panels on the top of the bumper and remove hardware located inside. See **Figures 4 and 5**.






- 7. Remove the rear bumper from the vehicle.
- 8. Remove the corner panels from the rear bumper. Remove all push pin clips retaining the corner panels. See **Figure 5**.
- 9. Gently pry and pull the (4) parking sensors from the bezels.

*Note:* Be very careful when removing parking sensors. Be sure to keep the rubber gaskets on the parking sensors.

- 10. Gently remove all the wiring clips from the OEM bumper.
- 11. Remove the keyless entry antenna located at the center of the bumper by removing the nut holding it in place.
- 12. Remove the trailer plug located on the inside of the bumper.
- 13. Remove the blind spot sensors from each side of the bumper. Remove the nuts holding them in place. See Figure 6.
- 14. Grind the studs located near the hitch off of the frame. See Figure 7.






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- 15. Remove the clips on the side of the fame on the driver and passenger side.
- 16. Loosely install the mounting brackets (items 2 and 3) using the M12 Mounting hardware (items 16-19). See **Figures 8 and 9**.






17. Attach the blind spot sensors onto the sensor brackets (items 6 and 7) using the M6 Hex head hardware (items 12-15). See **Figures 10-12**.







18. Install the sensor cover (item 8), sensor plate (item 9), and sensor brackets (items 6 & 7) onto the bumper using the M6 hardware (items 21, 24, and 26) see **Figures 12-14**.







- 19. Loosely install the Sensor L-Tabs (item 5) using the M6 hardware (items 12,20-23). See Figures 15 and 16.
- 20. If parking sensors are equipped, remove the plugs from the parking sensor holes. Install the parking sensors into the bumper where the Sensor L-Tabs were mounted and secure them by tightening the M6 hardware 10.5 lb-ft. Place (1) piece of double sided foam tape (item 27) between each parking sensor and Sensor L-Tab.
- 21. If lights (PN 09-1918FM6) are being installed, remove the mesh covers and install them in the slots. Secure them with the hardware provided with the lights.


*Note:* Lights are sold separately.

- 22. Install the wiring harness to the blind spot monitor and parking sensors.
- 23. Install the trail plug onto the bumper.






- 24. Mount the bumper onto the mounting brackets using M12 hardware (items 10 and 11) See Figure 17.
- 25. Connect the main wiring harness and trailer plug.
- 26. Adjust the bumper and tighten the M12 Hardware to 70 lb-ft.
- 27. Install the rear license plate using the M6 hardware (items 21, 22, 26, and 25).





#### CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
